

## RACE 1

**Emblessed (2)** has scored twice over this trip and is in rattling form. Hard to get past him. **Dreamcatcher (4)** is back on Polytrack, the surface he last scored on, and is dropping back in distance as well. Must be respected. **Seize The Day (3)** has been around the mark of late including two seconds and one win. Keep in your calculations. **Charly B (1)** seems to have hit form again, but is drawn awkwardly. Place claims better.

## RACE 2

**Full Toss (1)** is knocking on the door. He made good ground at his last run over the mile. Shaping up as a threat, especially with Joao Moreira aboard. **Prize Fighter (7)** has early pace but tends to be found wanting in the end. Faces moderate field and if he gets his way in front, he could steal a march. **Abastor (2)** is running consistently well these days. The step-up in distance looks like right up his alley. **Rockety Cat (11)** closes in late and will appreciate the extra 400m. Outside chance.

## RACE 3

**Phantom Knight (1)** will be one of the late swoopers again. If his run is timed properly, he may take the measure of this lot. **Agenais (6)** is holding form and looks suited in this race, especially from barrier No 1. **The Cinderella Man (5)** has not put a foot wrong except at his only start on turf in last four runs. Drawn nicely this time. Deserves respect. **Raffles Knight (9)** has pace and is wearing blinkers for the first time. If he can steady up the pace better upfront, he may hold on for a place.

## RACE 4

Not much to get too excited over but last-start winner **Star Ballad (3)** may well double the dose. **Distinct Niche (7)** ran a fighting second to Scandal last time out. Will get run of the race from barrier No 2. Form hard to fault. **King Of Lotus (11)** runs on in his races. With some luck, he may hold on to a place. **Merlin (2)** makes some ground late but this is a tougher proposition. Place claims.

## RACE 5

**Super Good (1)** was slightly disappointing second-up after showing above-average ability at his debut win. Merits consideration again. **Pitstop (10)** ran a cracking second at debut and on that strength should be a strong factor again. **Rising Empire (2)** showed he was among the leading two-year-olds following his impressive second-up win in the sixth Leg. Go close again. **Rory (12)** was not 100% ready at debut but still raced out of his skin for third. He would have improved a few lengths since and is a solid candidate for the minors.

## RACE 6

Last year's champion three-year-old **Gingerbread Man (1)** is at his comeback race since he returned from his unsuccessful Dubai trip. He looks well on training track and ran second to KrisFlyer contender Captain Obvious in a barrier trial on Tuesday. **Hammer Down (6)** was soundly beaten at his last start but has no weight on his back this time. Top hope. On his last-start surprise all-the-way win, **My Son (5)** must be rated with a high chance. Drawn an alley. One for the money. **Mr Timely (4)** turned in a blinder without the blinkers on last time. Each-way claims.

#### **RACE 7**

The well-named **Super Easy (1)** will be very hard to beat especially as he is so well-in on weights. He is undefeated in nine runs and is gunning for the Singapore Three-Year-Old Challenge Triple Crown. Only concern is the first test over the mile but looking at the way he raced away in the second Leg over 1400m, the trip should not pose any problem. **Better Life (12)** will appreciate the mile better and must be treated with respect. **Totality (6)** stuck on well behind Super Easy in the second Leg. He also looks like he can handle the mile and should represent a big threat. **Shuttle Man (13)** did not handle the wet conditions at his last start. If the track stays firm, he should make his presence felt.

#### **RACE 8**

Promising sort **Birthday Gift (2)** is gunning for a two in a row. He claimed the scalps of two good horses at his last two runs. Only hiccup is the awkward alley. His main danger will be **Sulmona (7)**. Pacifiers are however off. **Maple Star (1)** flew home late at his last start but does break from an outside lane and dons blinkers for the first time. **Andiko (9)** is back on Polytrack after letting down powerfully on Polytrack last time out. May find this tougher, but if he can overcome his wide gate, he should be a source of danger.

#### **RACE 9**

**Williams (1)** mixes his form but on his day, he can take a hand in this. **Sacred Spring (7)** has finished in the money at his last three starts. Well drawn. Bears watching. American Vision scored his maiden in Restricted Maiden company and may find this a tad tougher. Not without a place chance. **Caiyaya (8)** ran on strongly at his last start. Drawn better this time. Place claims. **Video Call (1)** will find this easier but carries 58kg this time. Looks a threat nonetheless.
